# COMMON Q+A:

## Q: What happens if I don't register by the deadline?

**A:** We typically try to accommodate, however, there are times that an upcharge may be applied due to variance in pricing.

## Q: Can I change my room capacity?

**A:** Your trip leaders have determined the capacity options. Should you have a special request contact them first. There may be a price increase.

## Q: How are roommates selected?

**A:** Most trip leaders allow students to stay with friends so they are comfortable. They may make adjustments if they anticipate negative behaviors.

## Q: How does my child travel with dietary restrictions?

**A:** Upon registration there will be a place to record their needs. Please also communicate with their trip leaders about their preferences.

## Q: Can parents go?

**A:** Your Trip leader will decide which parents can attend and help with chaperone duties. Most chaperones are in charge of groups of students and headcounts before/after each activity. Parents typically choose a SINGLE or Double room upon registering for the trip.

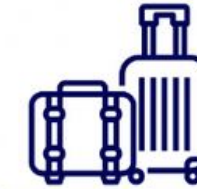
