Reflection: This tour takes you on paths that you wouldn't be able to reach on your own. How does that mirror your spiritual journey with God? Where have you seen God "steering" you in life?

Habakkuk 2:1 "I will stand at my watch and station myself on the ramparts; I will look to see what he will say to me..." Reflection: As you climb the Watchtower and take in the view, what new perspective do you gain about creation, about God, or about your own life?

Galatians 5:13 "Serve one another humbly in love." Reflection: How can we live out unity and love amidst cultural differences? What impact do you hope your work had, even if it was small or unseen? What is God inviting you to care for in your daily life?

Bryce Canyon National Park

Psalm 95:4-5 "In his hand are the depths of the earth, and the mountain peaks belong to him. The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land." Reflection: Each hoodoo in Bryce is uniquely shaped by wind, water, and time. What does that teach you about how God shapes each of us? Where in your life do you see God shaping something unique and beautiful, even if the process is slow or difficult?

Sand Sledding in Coral Pink Sand Dunes State Park

Matthew 7:24–27 "Everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock... but the foolish man built his house on the sand." Reflection: When you run, climb, or sled on sand, it constantly shifts. What areas in your life feel "unstable" like that? How does Jesus offer a foundation that doesn't shift even when life does? What's something in your life that might be built more on "sand" than "rock"? Where in your life do you need a more solid foundation in Christ?

Campfire with Smores

John 21:9-12 "When they landed, they saw a fire of burning coals... Jesus said to them, 'Come and have breakfast." Reflection: Jesus cooked breakfast for his disciples over a fire (John 21). How does that show us God is present in the small, simple moments? What are some "ordinary" moments from this trip where you've felt peace, connection, or joy? God is present even in s'mores and silence. Where else might he be showing up?
