





FAQ

Q: How does my child travel with dietary restrictions?

A: Upon registration there will be a place to record their needs. Please also communicate with their trip leaders about their preferences.

Q: How are roommates selected?

A: Most trip leaders allow students to stay with friends so they are comfortable. They may make adjustments if they anticipate negative behaviors.



Q: Can I change my room capacity?

A: Your trip leaders have determined the capacity options. Should you have a special request contact them first. There may be a price increase.

Q: What happens if I don't register by the deadline?

A: We typically try to accommodate, however there are times that an upcharge may be applied due to variance in pricing.
